it when we picked lemon.

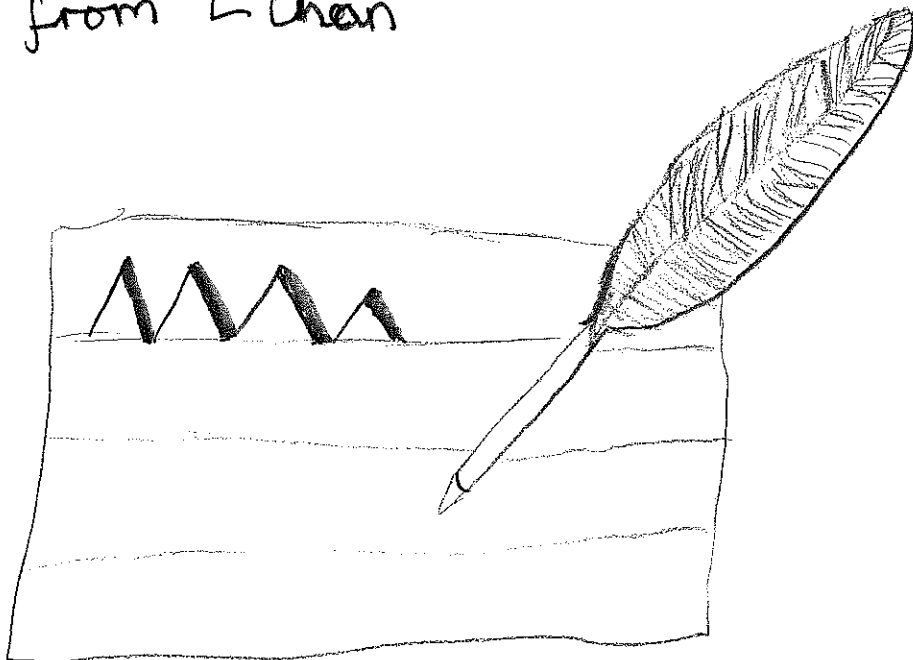
